## 1. Overview

PLAM is a Telegram Mini App that allows users to upload photos for broadcast within the PLAM ecosystem.

To ensure safety and compliance with platform rules, all uploaded content is subject to moderation.

## 2. Moderation Process

All uploaded photos undergo:

- Automated moderation using OpenAI technologies
- Manual review by PLAM administrators when necessary

Moderation time depends on queue volume and may take up to 3 hours.

## 3. Prohibited Content

The following content is strictly prohibited:

- Pornographic or explicit material (18+)
- Violent content
- Hate speech or discriminatory content
- Illegal activities
- Drugs or drug-related promotion
- Government IDs or official documents
- Bank cards or financial information
- Personal data of third parties without consent
- Images of minors without lawful authorization
- Spam or advertising content

## 4. Rejected Content

Photos that violate the rules are rejected and permanently deleted immediately after moderation.

## 5. Appeals

If a user believes their content was rejected incorrectly, they may submit an appeal via:

support@plam.space

Each appeal is reviewed individually.

## 6. Repeated Violations

PLAM reserves the right to:

- Issue warnings depending on severity
- Temporarily suspend accounts after repeated violations
- Immediately suspend accounts for severe violations

## 7. Final Decision

PLAM reserves the right to make final moderation decisions to ensure platform safety and compliance.
